Our corporate understanding first as disciples then as a church is the key to the restoration of all that was lost in Adam. Jesus spent the three years incubating this in the heart of his followers whom He called to follow Him. "And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men. And they straightway left their nets, and followed him." (Matthew 4:19, 20 KJV). The key to our formation is in the changing of our paradigm as we follow Jesus, the transformation that takes place to become like Him. Paul put it this way "My little children, of whom I travail in birth again until Christ be formed in you" Galatians 4:19 KJV). Jesus deliberately embarked on this mission when He came. "And he goeth up into a mountain, and calleth unto him whom he would: and they came unto him. And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach," (Mark 3:13, 14 KJV). The key for our formation is in this verses "to be with him" "they continue with him" "that they should be with him" "they were to accompany Him" "that they might be with him" " to continue to be with him" this is the key to a complete incubation on the life that God focuses upon in life.

Jesus came in the flesh to inaugurate a brand new race, start a brand new specie of people. His death was our death, His burial was our burial - the burial of the old nature and His resurrection was our new life. "For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead: And that he died for all.... Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, ...For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. (2 Corinthians 5:14, 15, 17, 20, 21 KJV). It's in this that a solid foundation is laid, not on faulty gospel but the complete gospel of Christ.

Growing Your faith in Christ Jesus

Having resolved that walking with God is a journey, a way, a way of life, a life style in which I must make progress, the issue of growth is not an option. Crave pure spiritual milk, just as the secret of the healthy growth of a child is the regularity of a right diet, so daily disciplined feeding is the major condition of
