AMBASSADOR'S BRIEF

"A church where everybody is somebody- Christ's Ambassadors"

"For we are God's [own] handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us [taking paths which He prepared ahead of time], that we should walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live]. " Ephesians 2:10 AMPC

(John 1:4-5, 16 AMPC).

Each space you gain in your daily pursuit stifles darkness of its operation. The invitation Jesus gave to us is into a realm, not theory or knowledge because knowledge puffs up, the realm is a mystery, operating this mystery is simply to live the lifestyle daily in the understanding that "I have been crucified with Christ [in Him I have shared His crucifixion); it is no longer I who live, but Christ (the Messiah) lives in me; and the life I now live in the body I live by faith in by adherence to and reliance on and complete trust in) the Son of God, Who loved me and gave Himself up for me." Galatians 2:20, 6:14 AMPC . Read Colossians 3:3, 2 Corinthians 5:14-20.

Paul said, "I die daily". I studied the context of his statement, "Else what shall they do which are baptized for the dead, if the dead rise not at all? why are they then baptized for the dead? And why stand we in jeopardy every hour? I protest by your rejoicing which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, I die daily. If after the manner of men I have fought with beasts at Ephesus, what advantageth it me, if the dead rise not? let us eat and drink; for to morrow we die. Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners. Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak this to your shame." 1 Corinthians 15:29-34 KJV.

If you carry this life that is light, "good communication a-flames bad manners", instead of the way the world uses this as a slogan- "evil communication corrupts good manners. Our commitment to the continuance is what establishes His kingdom here on earth. "Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. "*And Ruth said, Intreat me not to leave thee, or to return from following after thee: for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people shall be my people, and thy God my God: where thou diest, will I die, and there will I be buried: the LORD do so to me, and more also, if ought but death part thee and me.*" **Ruth 1:16-17 KJV**
